STUDENT SUPPORT

FNTI offers a **Learner Centered Environment** which respects Indigenous Learning Outcomes and provides excellent student support services. Each program has a **Student Success Facilitator** to help guide and support faculty and students. A **Cultural Advisor** is also present in each classroom to help **support the holistic well-being of the students.** If you need support don't be afraid to reach out. A helping hand will be there.

DELIVERY METHOD

FNTI features an **Intensive Professional Delivery Mode.** Class sessions usually take place over one week (5 days) every four to six weeks, during the academic year. This allows those with work, family, and other obligations to balance all of their commitments. It also allows employers to build capacity at work by granting students time away, while continuing on the job.

FOR EMPLOYERS
